# Tie Top Tote Bag









## Heather's Tie Top Tote Bag (This pattern is designed to be used alongside the video tutorial)

### PLEASE WATCH THE TUTORIAL BEFORE INTERFACING!

All sizes are in inches.

## Materials required

- Outer Fabric A half a metre
- Outer Fabric B half a metre
- Lining Fabric C half a metre
- Co-ordinating thread
- Size 80 for cotton poplin or quilting cotton. Size 90 for the canvas bag and the drill cotton on the grey bag.

#### INTERFACINGS FOR THE DIFFERENT BAGS

For the sunflower and the seashells Cotton Poplin and Quilting Cotton Bags.

- HN640 fusible fleece half a metre for the outer fabrics
- 614w lightweight fusible interfacing -2 metres for all the fabrics.

## For the pink Canvas Bag

- HFUS Medium/heavy weight fusible interfacing 1 meter for the outer and lining fabrics.
- 614w lightweight fusible interfacing half a metre for the handles and ties.

## For the grey and black bag.

- HN640 fusible fleece half a metre for the outer fabrics
- 614w lightweight fusible interfacing -2 metres for the upper outer fabrics, the ties and the lining
- The drill fabric on the outer bottom and the handles do not need to be interfaced.

## **CUTTING GUIDE (height x width)**

Outer fabric A 2 of 11 x 18

2 of 13.5 x 7.5

Outer fabric B 4 of 2 x 22

2 of 5 x 18

2 of 4 x 36

Lining fabric C 2 of 15 x 18

Fusible Fleece 2 of 11 x 18

2 of 5 x 18

Lightweight and Medium/heavyweight Interfacing – Check the above interfacing guides for the bag that you are making. For ease, interface all the pieces required onto the sheet at the same time and then and then cut them out.
